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SPECIAL “200th BIRTHDAY” DISCOUNT ON KENNEDY RANGE TAG-ALONG TOUR!

Keen 4WD'ers have a one-time-only opportunity to save \$200 per person - or \$500 per couple - when they join the Global Gypsies escorted and catered tag-along-tour to the Kennedy Ranges in July.

To celebrate the 200th birthday of Arthur Edward Kennedy, the Governor for whom the range was named, the Gypsies are offering a special '200th birthday discount' to the first three clients who book on the tour after reading this article.

The Kennedy Range is one of the most remote and least visited 4WD destinations in WA, yet one of the most scenic and inspiring. An eroded plateau situated on the rim of the Gascoyne River catchments about 150 kms east of Carnarvon, the Kennedys boast spectacular gorge scenery and a vast plateau of ancient dunefields on top of the range. Discovered in 1858, the area still retains a wilderness feeling - camping beneath the stark sandstone cliffs is a must for any outback enthusiast.

The self-drive 4WD expedition begins in Carnarvon on July 1. Over the next 12 days the small group of adventurers will travel in convoy communicating by two-way radio. They will explore the seldom-traveled west side of the range then spend three days at the coastal paradise of Quobba Station before returning to Carnarvon on July 12. Accommodation will be under canvas, mainly in bush camps.

Tour Leader Jeremy Perks, Global Gypsies Director and former Tour Guide of the Year, says “In addition to revisiting areas we know and love, we will be conducting a ‘rekkie’ along the top of the Kennedy Range and go looking for another track that we know exists but have never used before. We will also travel on sand tracks that are new to us between Quobba and Gnarloo with plenty of time to fish, swim, snorkel and relax. It will be a real journey of discovery combining the thrill of early exploration with the creature comforts of today.”

Special features of the tour include delicious catering by Safari Hostess Rebina Criddle (three meals a day plus morning tea), free bush-skills survival presentation, “*Girlspeak*” 4WD seminar, star-gazing evening, 4WD practice, full moon in the bush and a sumptuous, al fresco, candlelit white-linen dinner on the last night. Arthur Edward Kennedy never had it so good!

The tour normally costs \$2090 per person (\$4180 per couple) including catering, camping fees, park entry fees, comprehensive Pre Departure Kit and the services of a professional Tour Guide and Safari Hostess. With the special 'Kennedy 200 birthday discount' the price is just \$1890 per person or \$3680 per couple. Numbers are strictly limited.
