In addition to the services of a professional Tour Guide and a Safari Hostess, the package includes a specially equipped 4WD lead vehicle with recovery & communications equipment; custom-designed catering trailer; information & commentary on the destinations visited; overnight camping fees; permits and entry fees to national parks; comprehensive Pre Departure Workshop and Pre Departure Kit; 4WD practice; all meals and special white linen & candlelight Farewell Bush Dinner. Optional hire of 4WD vehicle, two-way radio and/or camping gear can be arranged at special rates if required.

There is only one departure to the Kimberley leaving Broome on June 3 and numbers are strictly limited. The cost of the package is \$2670 per person including meals, or \$167 per person per day including meals if participants wish to join only part of the safari. There are also two passenger seats available in the escort vehicle at a cost of \$2950 per person.
